

## 5th - 6th Grade Classroom Supply List

- 1 zippered pencil case (approx. 7" X 10")
- 6-Pocket Folders – Math, Grammar, Writing, Home Folder, Religion, Social Studies
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 12 blue or black ink pens, 12 Red pens
- 4-large glue sticks, 1 small bottle of Elmer's Glue
- 5- 8-1/2" X 11" spiral one subject notebooks (70 pages, wide ruled) One each for writing, journal, grammar, science, and social studies
- 2 packages of 4" X 6" lined index cards
- 1 ruler – custom and metric units (inches and centimeters)—**No bendable rulers please**
- Protractor
- Bow Compass (It has a screw to adjust)
- 1 pair of Scissors
- 36 #2 pencils – plain pencils preferred (mechanical pencils are acceptable but are the students responsibility)
- 2-erasers (try to find the white ones)
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 set of broad line colored markers, 1 set of fine line colored markers
- 1 pack of 1 ½" x 2" post-it notes (replenish as needed)
- 2 yellow highlighters and 2 of a different color- 4 total
- 2 black sharpie markers
- 1 Quadrille notebook (5 sq. per in.) for science
- 1 pair of gym shoes for gym to be left at school
- 3 boxes of facial tissues, 2 rolls of paper towels, 1 family size package of napkins
- 1 box of band-aids (no antibiotic please)
- USB flash drive
- 1-6.5 quart clear view Sterlite plastic shoebox w/removable lid (This can be purchased at Target or Wal-Mart.) Please label box.
- **CALCULATORS:** Calculators are required. **Fifth graders it would be helpful if we all had the same calculator. I would be happy to purchase them for the class. Please send \$10.00 with your student the first week of school if you would like me to purchase one for your student.** This is not required, just a recommendation.
- **Calculator - Pre-Algebra** (TI-30 preferred), **Algebra** (TI-84 Plus C Silver Edition- graphing calculator) We will have a few graphing calculators in class for use, but students will not be allowed to bring them home.
